

Debbie Beaudoin (Program Manager and Private Instructor)

Debbie continued to play for Quinnipiac till her graduation year where she was selected by her team mates and coaches to captain the team. While at Quinnipiac, Debbie maintained a Dean Roll Status and was in the top percentage of her class and team mates. After graduation, Debbie moved to the eastern provinces to continue her professional career as a hockey player. In 2004-05 Debbie played with the Telus Lighting (NHL) in Ajax Ontario and was also selected to represent BC at the Esso Nationals. In 2005-06 she played with the Quebec Avalanche (NHL). While in our eastern provinces Debbie took on the roll as the Program Coordinator at our Canlan facility in Oshawa. In 2006, she decided to move back home to BC where she is now the Program Manager and instructor with Canlan Twin Rinks. Debbie was also a member of the BC Breakers Western Women's Hockey League for 2 years. During 2007-2008
