



The following questions were asked by potential bidders on the project along with answers to questions.

1. Will you accept more than one option from respondents?

**Yes**

2. Is there a budget assigned to this project?

**Under \$90,000 GST not included.**

3. Appendix C – 1 state that we are to “oversee installation with the local installer.” Does this mean that the cost of installation is not to be part of this contract (only supervision)?

**Yes we have a service group that is willing to provide the labour but the supplier is to provide over sight of the installation for the service group.**

4. It is not clear where the two areas listed are located within the park, can a sketch or site plan be provided?

**The area is roughly in where the existing swing set is currently located. Swing set is to be removed by Parks and Recreation Staff and not included in the bid for the upgrade.**

5. Is any of the existing playground equipment to remain?

**Everything but the large swing set is to remain.**

6. Is demolition of existing playground equipment to be part of this contract?

**No**

7. Is the existing EWF surfacing to be completely removed, or can it be reused?

**Existing EWF to be used for existing playground and new EWF to be provided for new play area.**

8. What is your file size restriction for email submission?

**2 Mb**

9. Can you clarify this scope of work for the successful proponent?

The winning proponent is responsible for only supply and a supervised installation? And the installer is chosen by ASPRD, and not the responsibility of the bidder?

***The proponent is to supply equipment and supervise the installation. We have arranged for a local service group to donate labour for the installation of the structure.***

All areas of prep work, removal of existing equipment, excavation, installation of materials and equipment to do so is not the responsibility of the winning bidder?

***The supply of the equipment and supervision of the installation of the equipment is the responsibility of the bidder.***
